## **Standard Operating Procedure for Monkey-Pox USM (IMTGT 2024):**

Give Health Alert Card.  Sterilization and disinfection of the room , bathroom and all surfaces.  End	1. Delegates and Athletes who are symptomatic:  Symptoms are any of the following:  a. Acute onset of fever (>38.5°C) b. Headache c. Myalgia (muscle pain/body aches) d. Back pain e. Profound weakness/fatigue.  OR Unexplained skin rash since January 2022, mucosal lesions. Skin rash may include single or multiple lesions in the anogenital region or other parts of the body.  OR Lymphadenopathy (Classical sign of Mpox).  1(i). If having cough or upper respiratory tract infection with the above symptoms, screen for COVID and Influenza (follow SOP Covid and Influenza)  2. Suspected cases are isolated in rooms with individual bathrooms an advised to stay there for the duration of their stay. Samples for screening, duration of isolation, permission to return home will depend on instructions by the health inspector and the local health department.	Team Supervisors. 3. Cases with severe symptoms are referred to the nearest hospital for treatment. Dedicated **Examining Doctor** ambulance will be provided from Hospital. 4. Notification of case to the Health department **Examining Doctor** and Action Room Pusat Sejahtera **Health Inspector** 5. For close contacts of positive cases please follow SOP for close contacts. 6. When the event is over, the case is allowed to return home with a Health Alert Card. **Discharging Doctor** 7. The room vacated and the bathroom is then disinfected and sterilized with diluted Clorox 1:10. Ensure cleaning staff are **Cleaning Staff** in full PPE. All disposable items must be placed in Supervised by Health yellow biohazard bags Inspector Pusat Sejahtera and disposed of in Pusat and selected nursing staff Sejahtera. 8. At all times staff in contact with cases must be in full PPE, cases are advised to wear face mask at all times when in Information contact with health care staff and are advised to maintain good hygiene. Recommended distance from case is 1 meter.
