RULES AND REGULATIONS ON THE STUDENT SEMINAR

Objectives

- Students from each member university will have the opportunity to share and exchange their experiences among the others.
- Students from each member university will have more opportunities to closely learn and know to each other.

Number of Participants

- The total number of students in the seminar activity is limited to 4 students and 1-2 advisors.

Documentation Management and Theme of the Student's Seminar

- Student delegates from each participating university must submit their paper manuscripts and electronic file to the host university. The paper manuscript must be prepared and conform to the format specified by the host university. The manuscript should be composed of the following items.
 - Title
 - Author, Affiliation, e-mail
 - Abstract and Keyword
 - Introduction
 - Content: Methodology, result, and discussion
 - Conclusion
 - Reference
- The paper manuscript and electronic file should be submitted to the host university at least one month before the conference day of the IMT-GT Varsity Carnival Seminar Activity, at which the host university will have enough time to arrange all papers to proceed.

Conference Days

- The conference days shall be composed of procedures and items as follows.
 - Each university will be allocated 20 minutes (10 minutes presentation +10 minutes Q&A session).
 - English is a medium language used for the IMT-GT Varsity Carnival Seminar Activity.

- Manuscript consists of Title, Author, Affiliation, Correspondence Email, Abstract and Keywords, Introduction, Discussion, Conclusion/Suggestion, References and Reviewers)/ Editor (s).
- Abstract consists of main issues, discussion, and conclusions/suggestions. Abstract is written in Times New Roman 12, single space, single lines, and with maximum 150-200 words. Keywords: consist of 5-8 words, which are separated with commas.
- Body text is written in 2 columns, 1.5 space, Times New Romans 12 with bold and capital for the headings, and normal for the text, maximum 15 pages, and uses A4 (29,7 x 21 cm) paper size, with 4 cm for the left margin and 3 cm for the rest (right, top and bottom).
- Introduction includes the background of issues, scope of the discussion purposes or importance of discussing and solving the issues. In this part author might also include some relevant literature reviews, both theoretical and empirical ones.
- Discussion presents information, facts, arguments, or ideas that will be concluded in the Conclusion/Suggestion part. The arguments or ideas can be supported or linked with literature reviews that have been described in the introduction.
- The conclusion could be completed by some practical suggestions or policy implications for IMT GT countries.
- References are written in APA style. For details please consult <https://owl.english.purdue.edu/owl/resource/560/01/>. Information of references used in the manuscript is expected to help readers that are interested in further exploring the issues.
- Submitted paper needs to be edited both in content, language and format. Editors' name are mentioned at the end of the body text.

CREATIVE MEDIA FORMAT GUIDELINE FOR MIX GROUP TASK

FIELD TRIP ACTIVITY GUIDE TO GEORGETOWN UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE AND PENANG HILL WORLD NETWORK OF BIOSPHERE RESERVES (WNBR)

This field trip will be held in Penang Island. The purpose of this field trip is as follows:

- Make observations and learn about the tourist heritage of the Georgetown (UNESCO World Heritage Site) and Penang Hill (World Network of Biosphere Reserves WNBR).
- Observes the life of the people, the arts, culture, and customs as well as biosphere ecosystems at the sites
- Activities in Georgetown or Penang Hill will become material for group presentations with the theme " The World Heritage: Preserving the Past, Sustaining the Future " the following day.
- Each group is to choose **ONLY ONE** of the above places for the group task completion
- Each group is required to create creative and innovative ideas according to the theme given
- Each group needs to present (in creative and informative tools eg: PowerPoint, sitcom, acting, etc.) within a 15-minute time frame, followed by a 10-minute question and answer session with the judges.

FIELD TRIP ACTIVITY GUIDE TO GEORGETOWN UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE AND PENANG HILL WORLD NETWORK OF BIOSPHERE RESERVES (WNBR)

Things to Look For:

1. Preparation and Information:

- Learn basic information about Georgetown and Penang Hill before the field trip.
- Identify aspects of ecotourism focusing on both sites.
- Dress neatly and politely during field trip activities.
- Bring a field notebook to record observations and findings during the visit.
- Bring a camera or cellphone to record or take pictures during the field trip activities.

2. Ethics and Interaction with Local Communities:

- Maintain good manners and respect the customs and habits of the local community.
- Interact with local residents in a friendly, respectful, and attentive manner.
- Avoid disturbing the locals' daily activities and keep the environment clean during the visit.

Things to Look For:

3. Security and Safety:

- Comply with the instructions and directions from the group leader and officers on duty at the sites.
- Always stay in a group and not walking alone in unsafe places.
- Report any safety concerns immediately to the group leader or officer on duty.

4. Environment and Hygiene:

- Maintain the cleanliness of the environment during the visit.
- Avoid littering and follow applicable regulations regarding environmental preservation.

DEADLINE:

Paper submission: 8 August 2024

Review Process: 14-24 August 2024

NOTES:

- Manuscript format guidelines will be emailed to each seminar PIC of each university.
- Paper manuscript must be in English and reviewed by the Advisor(s) before submission.
- Paper manuscripts must be submitted to the host university no later than the stipulated due date. Any manuscript submitted after the due date will be disqualified from the Best Paper Award. However, the team will still be allowed for other Awards.
- Manuscripts will be published in Seminar Proceedings
- The Best Overall Paper Award will be given to delegates based on the combination of a manuscript (60%), presentation (30%), and discussion/Q and A session (10%) by the panels (except the same University of the panelist)
- Each delegate/ university consists of four (4) students and 1-2 advisors. Delegates will be divided into six (6) mixed groups based on the sub-themes.
- Each mixed group will consist of eight (8) students from all three (3) countries: Indonesia, Malaysia, and Thailand. The mixed groups will run for the Best Mixed-Group Award based on the task given during the field trip and group presentation session.
